Figure 1: Map of sample locations across the Hawaiian Archipelago. Samples were collected from the 5 major islands in the Hawaiian archipelago: Hawai'i, Maui, Moloka'i, Oʻahu, and Kaua'i. Sampling was most dense on Hawai'i and on Oʻahu islands, where accessibility was easiest. Our sampling strategy was to use elevational transects where possible, in order to capture elevational and climatic variation. Elevations in figure legend are meters above sea level. This is visible in the transects on Hawai'i, Moloka'i, Kaua'i, and Oʻahu, which run orthogonally to the topographic lines (white). Transects are less pronounced on Maui because of limited accessibility.
