


Figure 1: Screenshot of the Gapminder-inspired application showing the same state as the usage scenario in authoring mode.




Figure 2: Screenshot of the Gapminder-inspired application showing the same state as the usage scenario in exploration mode.




Figure 3: Screenshot of the Gapminder-inspired application in authoring mode showing the combination of selection with annotation and custom mouse interaction.
